Redemption Information

To redeem your Kirtland's Warbler GeoTrail Passport for a trackable coin, please do the following:

- Visit at least 20 GeoTrail locations and sign the log.
- Each cache will contain a question, found on the inside lid. You will find the answer to the question in the description on the cache page. The answer is the code word.
- Fill in all 20 GeoTrail code words in proper locations on the GeoTrail passport
- Log all finds under your team name on the official listing on Geocaching.com for each GeoTrail location.

Complete the team name and mailing information on your passport.

Log entries and answers will be verified before coins are given out. Only one coin will be given out per official geocaching team name. Coins are limited and will be awarded on a first come, first served basis. There will be a \$10 fee for each coin. This covers the cost of the coin and postage.

Please be respectful of the area, and do not go beyond any posted breeding habitat signs.
